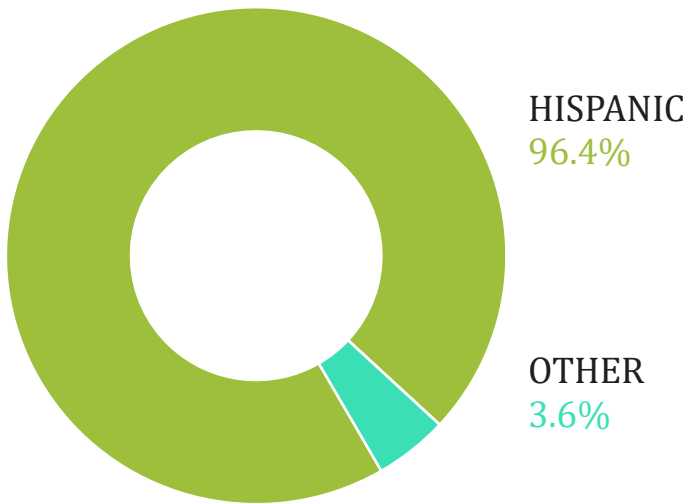

Student Demographics

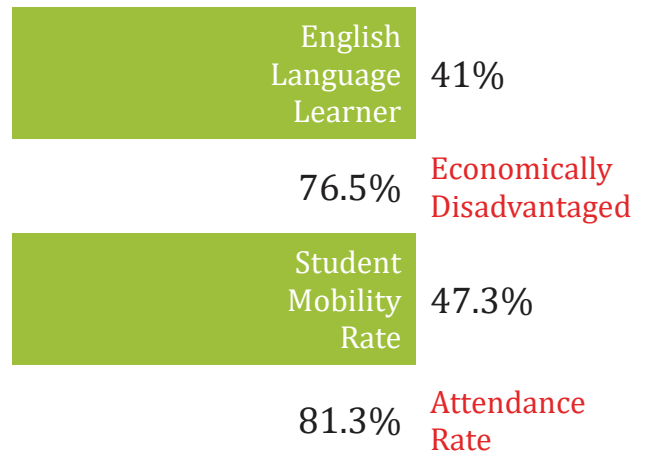

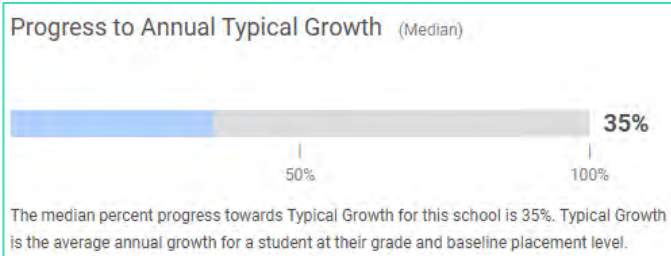

#1 By FY2028, the overall percentage of students reaching proficiency or above on state **English Language Arts** tests will increase by **20%**.

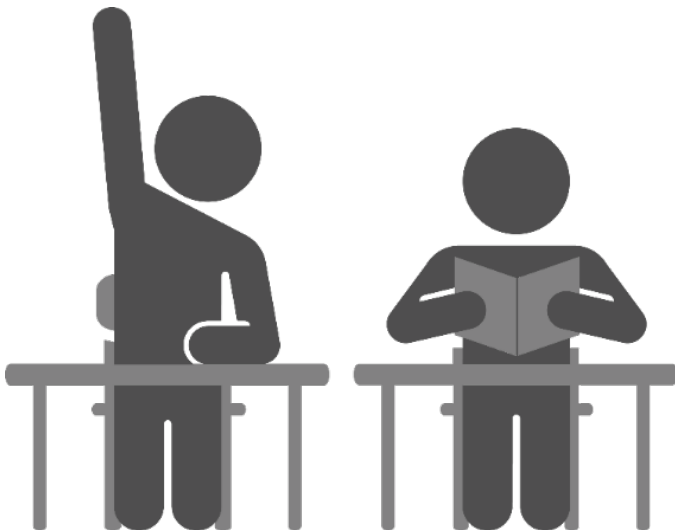
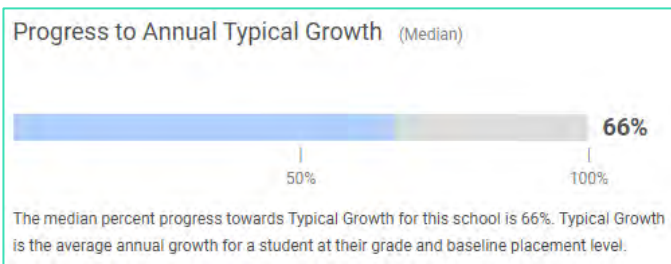
#2 By FY2028, the overall percentage of students reaching proficiency or above on state tests in **Mathematics** will increase by **20%**.
